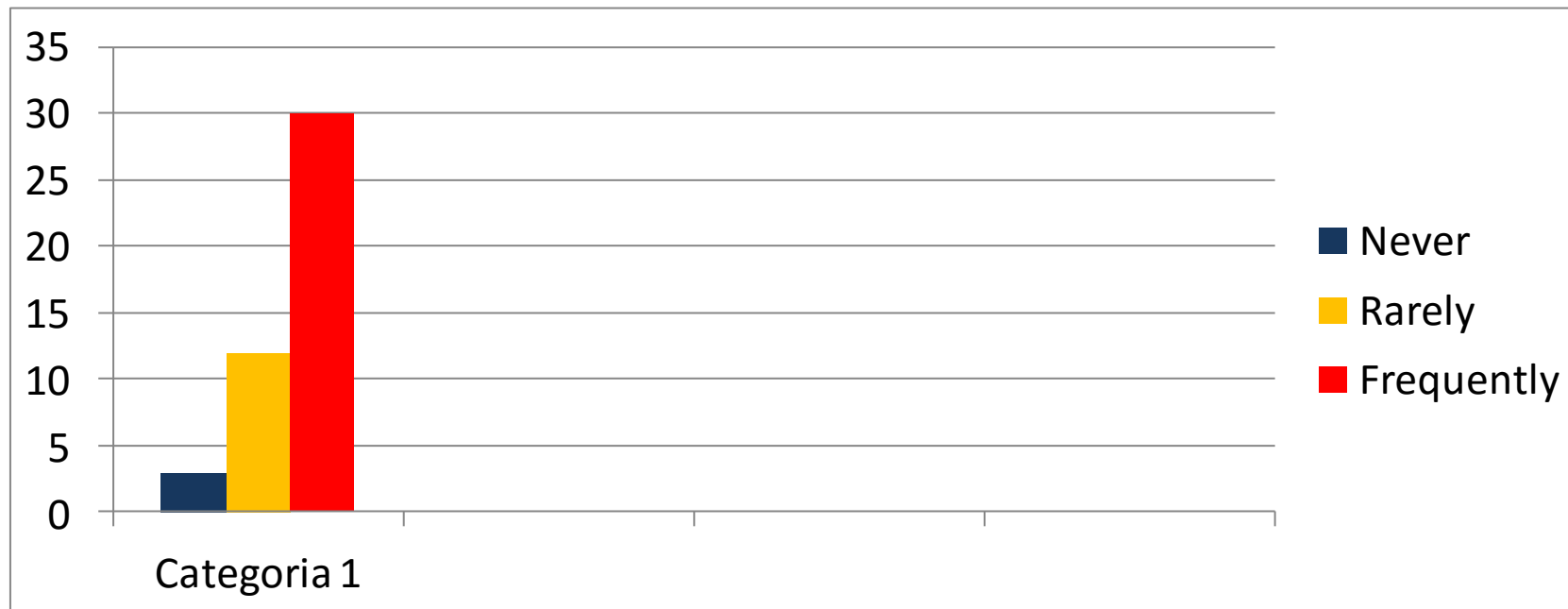

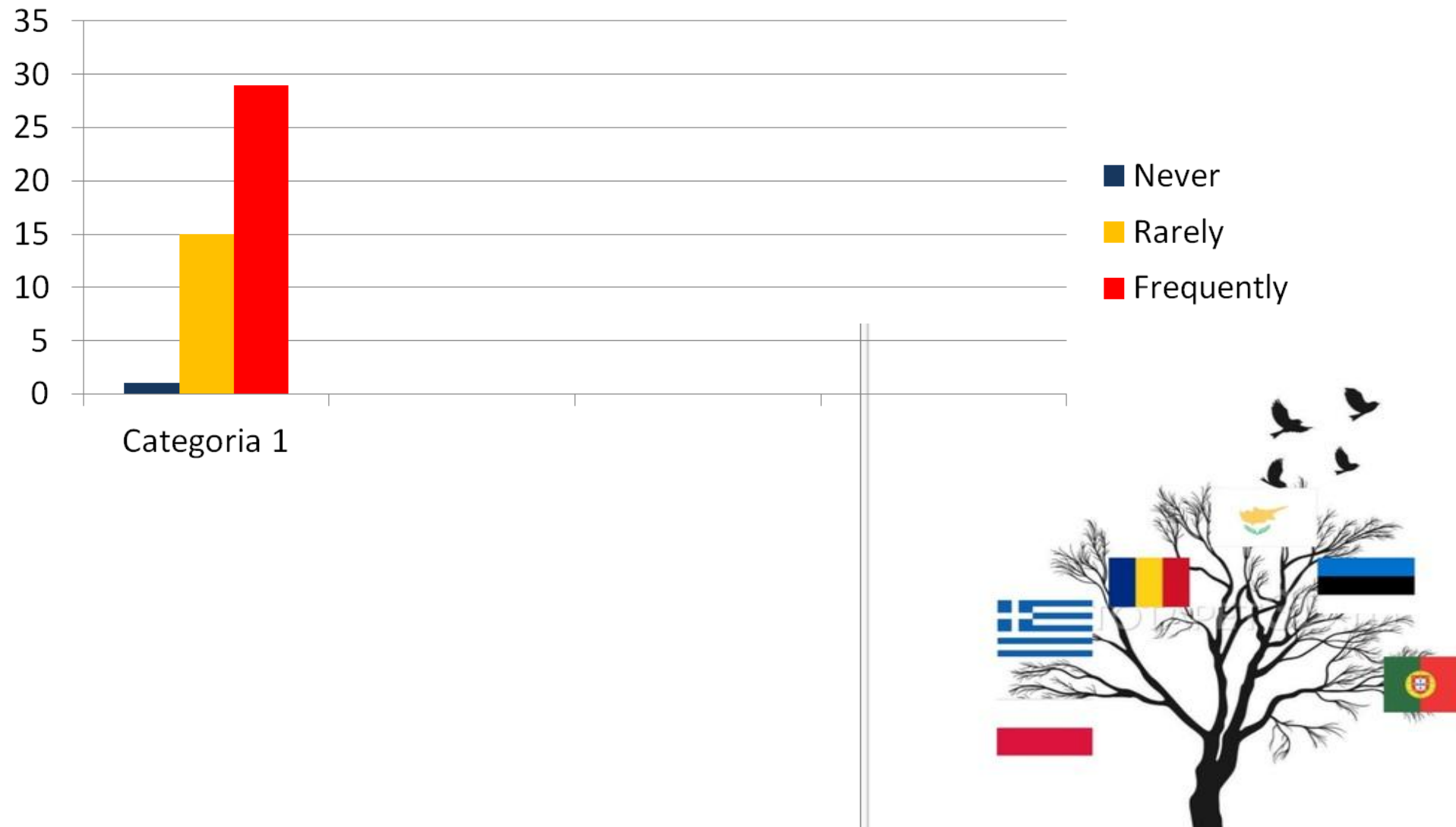
- **45 parents completed the questionnaire. They are aged between 29 and 46.**
- **Their answers are:**



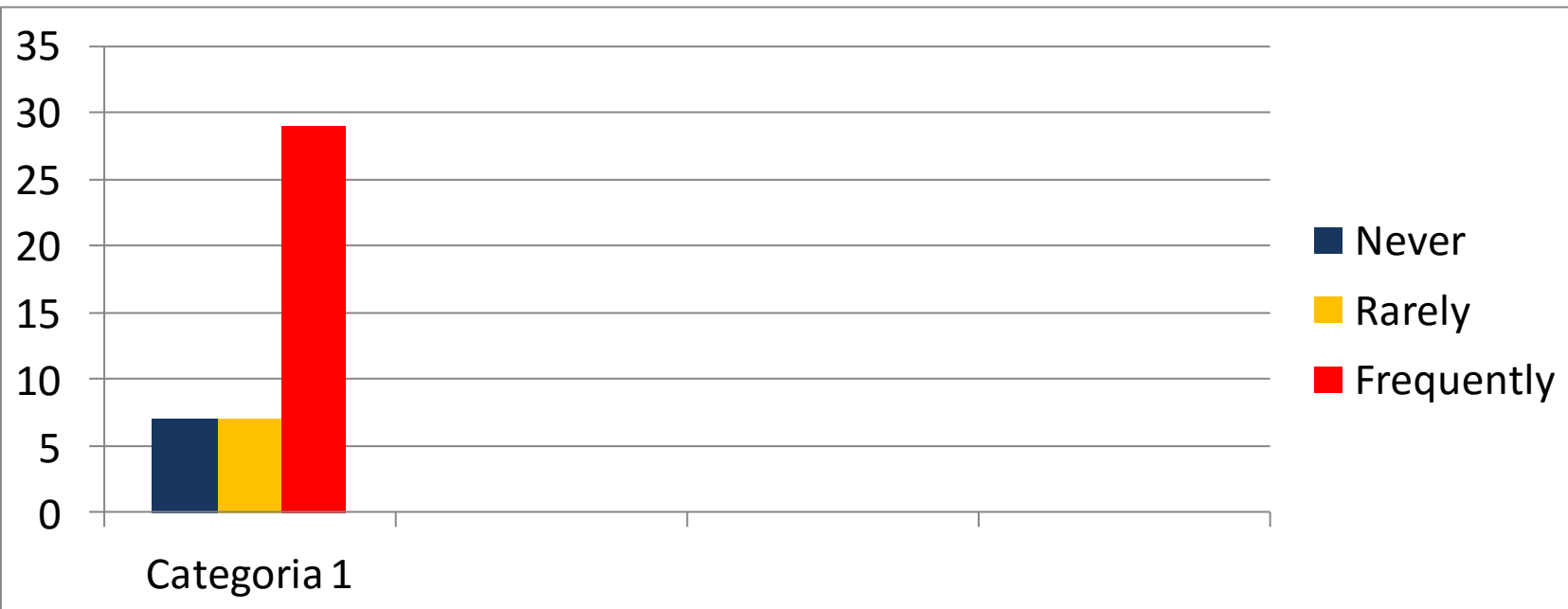
1. My children and I often visit cultural sites or events (e.g. cultural festivals) in our country in/or abroad.



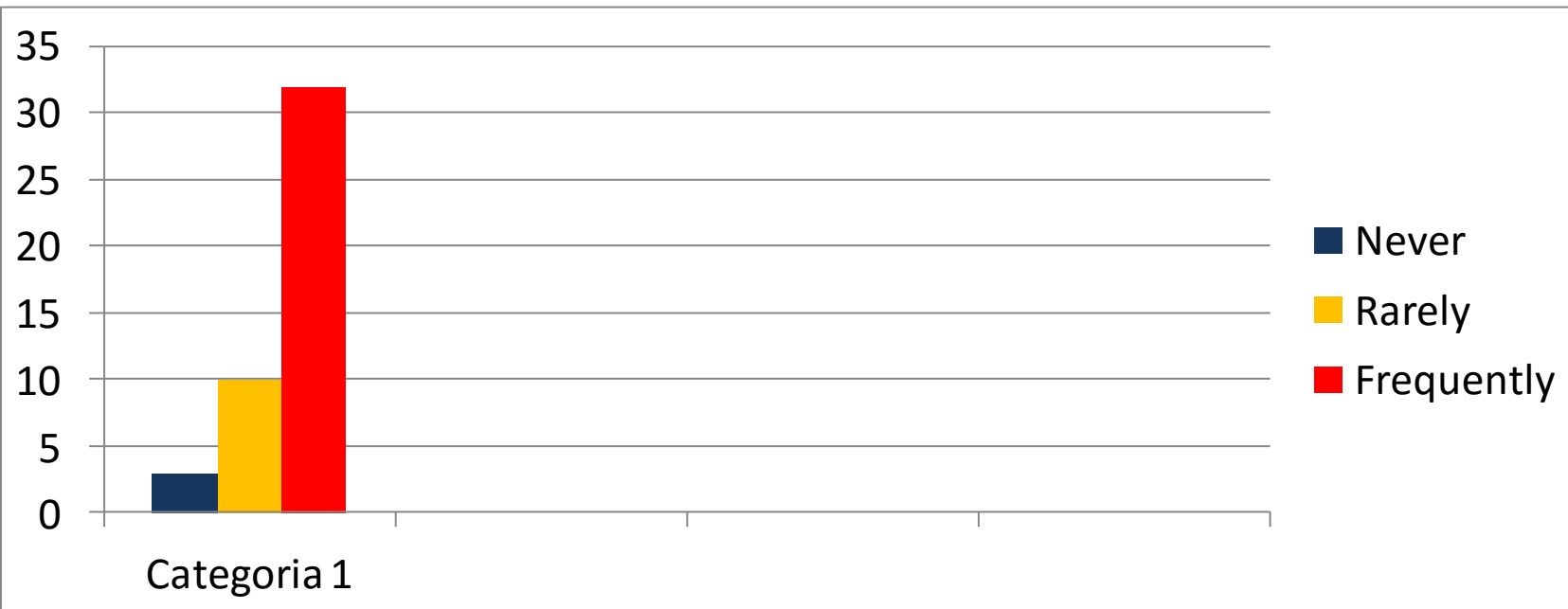
2. My children have opportunities at school to meet our cultural heritage.



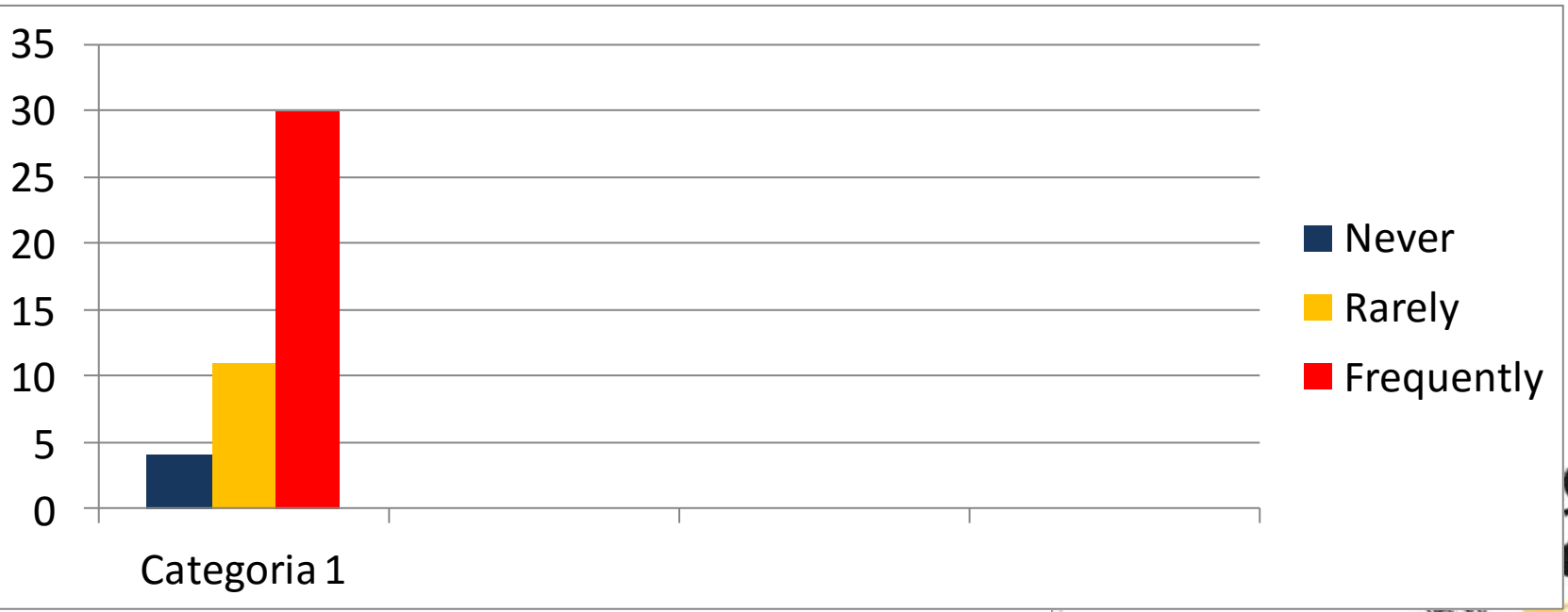
I believe that the cultural heritage is significant for our children future.



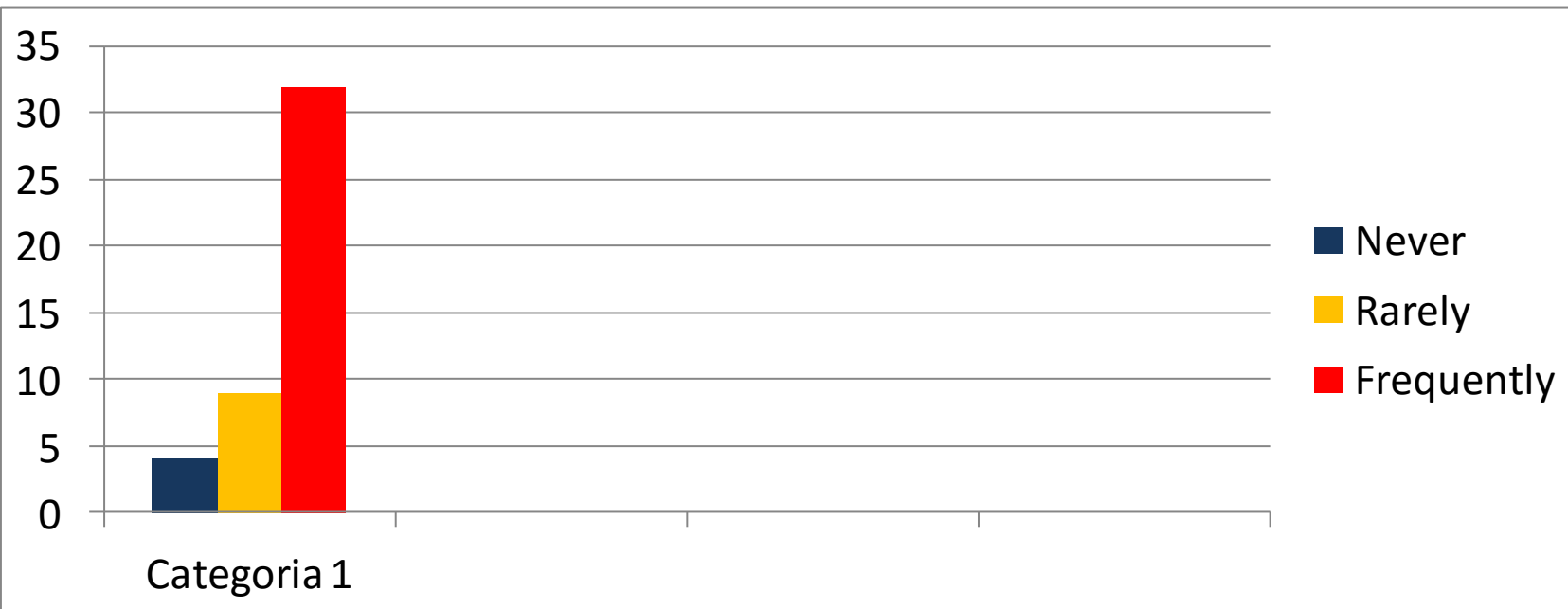
3. The cultural heritage must be a part of the curriculum.



4. My children at school participate in activities that promote their interests and skills.



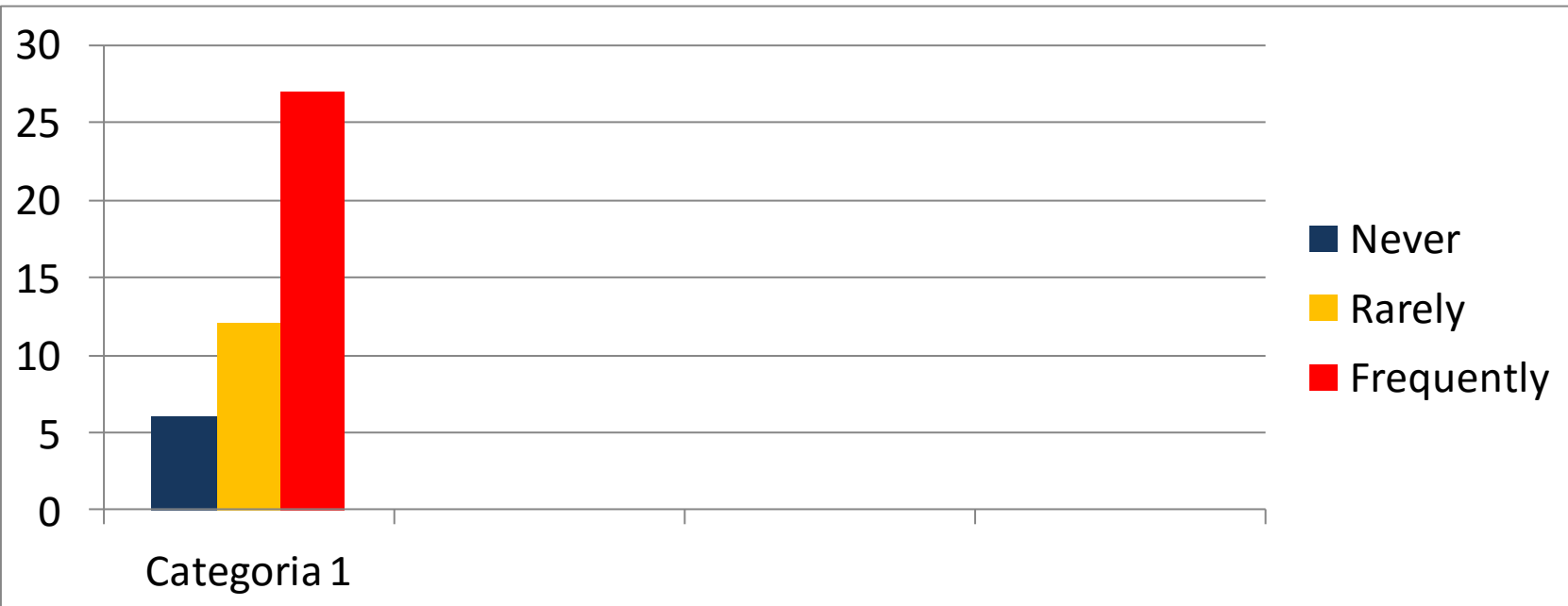
5. My children mention that they have some responsibilities in class.

7. I participate in events or lectures organized at the school.



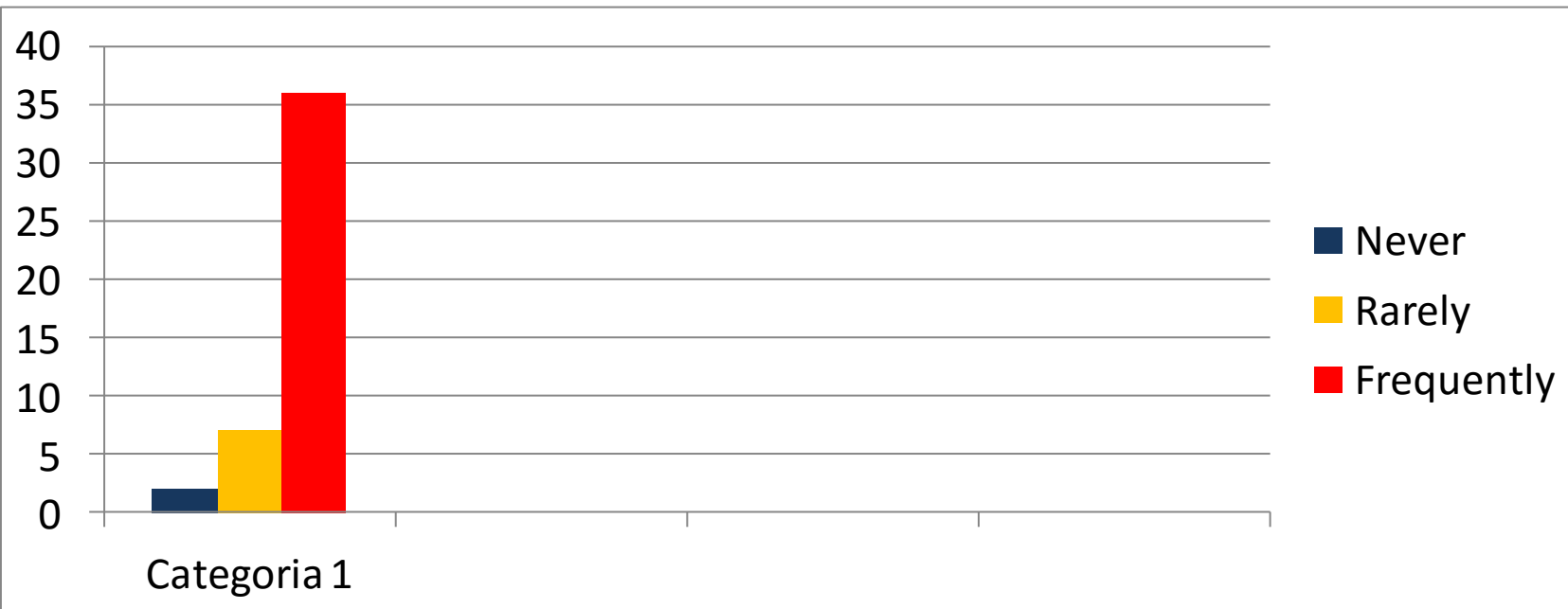
8. I use the school webpage to find out about events and activities.
